The Shoshone- Paiute Tribe's new Juvenile Services Center will provide a continuum of services including intake and assessment, detention, education, health services, and transition and aftercare services. IPFYouth has worked closely with the planning team and other interested parties to develop a transition and activation planning process and action plan for the opening and operation of the new facility. Tasks included:

- Transition training workshops with the client
- Identifying and organizing transition tasks into categories to be addressed by committees
- Developing systems to monitor process and track progress, information and decisions
- Initial outfitting assistance
- Assistance with staffing plans
- Participatory planning with various services providers to develop operational plans

IPFYouth provided additional assistance to the tribe during the planning, design and construction phases of the project in the capacity of the owner's representative. Tasks included:

- Program validation
- Design review
- Code compliance
